COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "/" to H.P. 857, L.D. 1214

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. Under this amendment, a 4 transmission and distribution utility may not release any customer-specific information licensed competitive to а electricity provider unless the provider produces sufficient 6 evidence, as defined by the commission by routine technical rule, 8 that the provider has obtained the customer's authorization. This amendment repeals a provision of law that prohibited large 10 transmission and distribution utilities from releasing propriety customer information without prior written authorization of the 12 customer. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
