	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §896, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
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6	4. Quorum. A guorum exists when a majority of elected voting members are present.
8	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §897, sub-§4, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 582, §1, is amended to read:
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12	A. The county commissioners may not further increase, decrease, alter or revise the budget adopted by the budget committee except by unanimous vote of the county
14	commissioners. Ifthe-adopted-budgetischanged-bythe eeunty-commissioners,the-budgetcommittee-may-reject-that
16	ehange-by-a-2/3-vote-of-its-membership. The budget is final and not subject to further action by either the county
18	commissioners or the budget committee upon <u>success or</u> failure of the commissioners to unanimously recommend
20	changes in the budget transmitted from the budget committee er-upon-acceptance-or-rejection-of-ohanges-by-the-budget

26	SUMMARY
28	This bill requires a majority of elected voting members of the Somerset County Budget Advisory Committee to be present to
30	constitute a quorum. This bill also gives the Somerset County Commissioners final say on the Somerset County budget.
