COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 871, L.D. 1228, Bill, "An Act to Increase Payments to Foster Parents"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill provides additional General Fund appropriations to the Department of Human Services in the amount of \$461,271 and \$676,530 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for increased payments to foster parents.

The bill also includes additional Federal Expenditures Fund allocations to the Department of Human Services in the amount of \$319,839 and \$469,097 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for increased payments to foster parents.

The additional costs associated with rulemaking can be absorbed by the Department of Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an appropriation, an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.
