

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. Rules. The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules to increase the payments to foster parents providing care for children by \$50 per month. Rules adopted pursuant to this Act are routine technical rules as defined by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

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SUMMARY

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This bill requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules increasing the payments to foster parents by \$50 per month. It designates the rules as routine technical rules.

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
