<b>26</b> 28	This amendment strikes the provisions of the bill increasing the penalties for certain crimes. As amended, this bill will
30	have no fiscal impact.

34	SUMMARY
36	This amendment changes the requirement for the return of a worthless instrument to a bank for collection from within 5 days
38	to within 10 days. The amendment also removes the decreases for the face value of worthless negotiable instruments and removes
40	the increase in penalty for a person who is convicted of more than one violation of passing a worthless negotiable instrument
42	with a face value of \$500 or less.
