2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §405, sub-§1, ¶D** is enacted to read:

6 D. A person may change the month in which a registration
8 expires by informing the registration agent of the choice
10 and paying a fee not to exceed \$10 to the agent. The
12 registration expires on the last day of the month of choice,
14 which may not be less than one year from the date of
issuance of the person's current registration. The excise
tax and registration fee must be adjusted to reflect the
number of months the registration is effective. A person
may change the month in which a registration expires once in
any 5-year period.

18 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill allows the owner of a registered motor vehicle to
22 change the month in which the registration expires once every 5
24 years. The bill allows a registration agent to charge a fee of
up to \$10 to accommodate the change.
