Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as folk

•-	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §405, sub-§1, ¶D is enacted to read:

	D. A person may change the month in which a registration
6	expires by informing the registration agent of the choice
	and paying a fee not to exceed \$10 to the agent. The
8	registration expires on the last day of the month of choice,
	which may not be less than one year from the date of
10	issuance of the person's current registration. The excise
	tax and registration fee must be adjusted to reflect the
12	number of months the registration is effective. A person
	may change the month in which a registration expires once in
14	any 5-year period.

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SUMMARY

This bill allows the owner of a registered motor vehicle to change the month in which the registration expires once every 5 years. The bill allows a registration agent to charge a fee of up to \$10 to accommodate the change.

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
