12	BOARD OF CEMETERY AND CREMATORY SERVICES
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16	§1391. Board of Cemetery and Crematory Services
16	1. Board. There is established the Board of Cemetery and
18	Crematory Services, as established by Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 47, referred to in this section as the "board."
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22	2. Membership. The board is composed of 5 members. The Attorney General is an ex officio member, and the 4 other members must be appointed by the Governor from a list of nominees
24	submitted to the Governor from a statewide cemetery association.
26	Board members must have at least 5 years experience in the
26	administration or operation of a cemetery or crematory.
28	3. Term: meeting; guorum. Each member of the board serves a term of 3 years. The board shall meet at least 4 times a
30	year. Three members of the board constitute a guorum.
32	4. Duties and responsibilities. The board shall:
