26	'Sec. 2. Membership; chair. Resolved: That the task force consists of no more than 6 members of the Joint Standing

30	1. No more than 2 members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; and
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34	2. No more than 4 members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House.
36	The Speaker of the House shall appoint the chair of the task force; and be it further

Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the task force shall review the structure and operation of the Board of Environmental Protection 2 to determine whether the board is operating as an independent body or as part of the executive branch of government, whether 4 the board has adequate administrative and technical staff and 6 whether the board's structure and operation provide for credible, fair and responsible public participation in the decision-making 8 process. In reviewing the board, the task force shall invite the participation of interested parties, including representatives of 10 environmental groups, representatives of business interests and property owners; and be it further

Sec. 5. Meetings. Resolved: That the task force may hold 5 14 meetings, and one of the meetings may be a public hearing; and be it further

Sec. 6. Compensation. Resolved: That the members of the task force are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at authorized meetings of the task force; and be it further

Sec. 7. Staff assistance. Resolved: That upon approval of the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis
 shall provide necessary staffing services to the task force; and be it further

Sec. 8. Task force budget. Resolved: That the chair of the task force, with assistance from the task force staff, shall administer the task force's budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the task force shall present a work plan and proposed budget to the Legislative Council for approval. The task force may not incur expenses that would result in the task force exceeding its approved budget; and be it further' 36

Further amend the resolve in section 5 in the last line 38 (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "force." and inserting in its place the following: 'force; and 40 be it further'

This resolve includes additional General Fund an appropriation to the Legislature in the amount of \$4,650 in 38 fiscal year 1999-00 for the per diem and expenses of legislative 40 members, costs to hold one public hearing and print the report of the Task Force to Study the Operation of and Support for the 42 Board of Environmental Protection.

The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the task force during the interim between 46 legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 48

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 899, L.D. 1256

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the membership of the Task Force to 4 Study the Operation of and Support for the Board of Environmental Protection to consist of a subcommittee that consists of no more 6 than 6 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources. It clarifies the duties, staffing and compensation of 8 the task force, and authorizes the task force to hold 5 meetings, including one public hearing. The amendment also adds an 10 appropriation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
