24	11 to 13 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
26	'Starting September 1, 2000, the minimum hourly wage is \$5.50 per hour. Starting September 1, 2001, the minimum hourly wage is
28	\$5.75 per hour. If the highest federal minimum wage is increased in excess of the minimum wage established in this subsection, the
30	minimum wage is increased to the same amount as the federal minimum wage, effective on the same date as the increase in the federal minimum wage.'

38	This amendment increases the minimum wage to \$5.50 per hour starting September 1, 2000 and to \$5.75 per hour starting September 1, 2001. This amendment also restores language in
40	current law tying any future increases in the minimum wage in Maine to increases in the federal minimum wage.
