32	This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$12,134 in fiscal year 2000-01.
34	As amended, this bill will require the revision of the minimum wage poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor
36	Standards. This bill requires that these costs, estimated to be \$12,134 in fiscal year 2000-01, be paid from the Special
38	Administrative Expense Fund. These costs will be absorbed by the
40	Department of Labor utilizing existing budgeted resources.
