SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 425, L.D. 1262, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Minimum Wage in Maine"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 3 indented paragraphs after the title and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 305, §1, is amended to read:

1. Minimum wage. The minimum hourly wage is \$4.25 \$5.15 per hour. ~~If the highest federal minimum wage is increased in excess of \$4.25 per hour, the minimum wage must be increased to the same amount, effective on the same date as the increase in the federal minimum wage, but in no case may the minimum wage exceed \$5.15 per hour.~~ Starting September 1, 2000, the minimum hourly wage is \$5.50 per hour. Starting September 1, 2001, the minimum hourly wage is \$5.85 per hour.

SUMMARY

This amendment lowers the increase in the minimum wage to \$5.50 per hour starting September 1, 2000 and \$5.85 per hour starting September 1, 2001.
