26	This bill will require the revision of the minimum wage poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards.
28	This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$12,134 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Labor for printing and
30	mailing costs. If other bills are enacted that also require changes to the poster, the cost properly allocated to this bill
32	can be reduced.'
34	SUMMARY
36	
38	This amendment provides for an increase in the state minimum wage to \$5.65 per hour beginning September 1, 2000 and to \$6.25 per hour beginning September 1, 2001. The amendment also adds an
40	appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
