COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 425, L.D. 1262, Bill, "An
Act to Increase the Minimum Wage in Maine"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the first
line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
"\$4.25" and inserting in its place the following: '~~\$4.25~~ \$5.15'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the
3rd line from the end (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "January" and inserting in its place the
following: 'September' and in the 2nd line from the end (page 1,
line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January" and
inserting in its place the following: 'September'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the
last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "\$6.15" and inserting in its place the following:
'\$6.25'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the
following:

'**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill will require the revision of the minimum wage poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards. This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$12,134 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Labor for printing and mailing costs. If other bills are enacted that also require changes to the poster, the cost properly allocated to this bill can be reduced.'

This amendment provides for an increase in the state minimum wage to \$5.65 per hour beginning September 1, 2000 and to \$6.25 per hour beginning September 1, 2001. The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
