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SUMMARY

10 This amendment is the minority report. This amendment adds 4 members to the Aroostook Water and Soil Management Board: 12 Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the Commissioner of Environmental Protection; a member representing a 14 conservation organization with membership in Aroostook County; and a representative of a sporting association with membership in 16 Aroostook County. The amendment also strikes and replaces the appropriation section and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
