#### 10 SUMMARY

This amendment provides funding for wage increases to workers employed by community mental retardation services providers. It directs the Commissioner of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to implement the wage increases through contracts and service agreements with community agencies. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
