32	A. Subject to law and the rules of the bureau, hotel <u>or bed</u> <u>and breakfast</u> licensees may sell liquor in the original packages or by the drink to bona fide registered room
34	guests. Any sale to a guest may be delivered to the guest's room only by a hotel <u>or bed and breakfast</u> employee.'
36	Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 913, L.D. 1291

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision of the bill allowing a bed and breakfast to acquire a Class I liquor license. It also allows a bed and breakfast licensee to deliver alcohol to a room in the bed and breakfast under certain conditions. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
