Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

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The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,880,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 and by \$2,880,000 in fiscal year 2000-01.

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SUMMARY


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This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation provided for the Travel Promotion Matching Fund and eliminates appropriations for contract services in the Office of Tourism.
