14 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 916, L.D. 1294, Bill, "An Act
16 to Provide for a Limited Waiver of Immunity"

18 Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd line
20 (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following:
"subsection 2" the following: 'and subject to paragraphs A and B'

22 Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 by
inserting at the end the following:

24 'A. If an action is brought against a charitable
26 organization, action against a director, officer or
28 volunteer arising from the same set of circumstances is
barred.

30 B. If an action is brought against a director, officer or
32 volunteer under this subsection, action against a charitable
34 organization arising from the same set of circumstances is
barred.'

36 **SUMMARY**

38 This amendment retains the limited waiver of immunity
40 established in the bill but prohibits a plaintiff from bringing
42 suit against both the charitable organization and the director,
officer or volunteer operating the vehicle.
