- 4. The Commissioner of Human Services or the commissioner's designee;
- 5. The Superintendent of Insurance or the superintendent's designee; and
  - 6. Two persons representing a statewide dental association, appointed by the Governor; and be it further
- Sec. 3. Appointments; meetings. Resolved: That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this Act. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council upon making their appointments. When the appointment of all members is complete, the chairs shall call and convene the first meeting of the task force no later than August 1, 1999; and be it further
  - Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the task force shall study alternative payment mechanisms for dental health care, including voucher systems, copayments and other mechanisms that allow for fair compensation for a dentist while reducing the amount of paperwork, and administration of the payment process; and be it further

Sec. 5. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide staffing assistance to the task force; and be it further

- Sec. 6. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the task force members who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, for each day's attendance at meetings of the task force. Public members not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities are entitled to receive a per diem equal to the legislative per diem for attendance at authorized meetings of the task force. All members of the task force are entitled to reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses upon application to the Legislative Council. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall administer the task force's budget; and be it further
- Sec. 7. Report. Resolved: That the task force shall submit its report with any accompanying legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by December 1, 1999. If the task force requires an extension of time to conclude its work and make its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension. Upon submission of its required reports and legislation, the work of the task force terminates; and be it further
