SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 928, L.D. 1305, Bill, "An Act to Establish and Fund Conflict Resolution Programs in the Public Schools"

Amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out all of the 6th line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$50,000'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 7th line (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Provides" the following: 'one-time'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01. As amended, this bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Education to provide grants to school administrative units for conflict resolution and peer mediation programs.

SUMMARY

This amendment reduces the amount appropriated for school conflict resolution programs from \$100,000 to \$50,000, and clarifies that the appropriation provides one-time funds.
