COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 972, L.D. 1370

Increasing the number of free combination fishing and hunting licenses will reduce annual General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$10,000 beginning in fiscal year 2000-01.'

SUMMARY

This minority amendment amends the bill by striking the section of the bill that reduces the age at which a citizen of 10 the State may obtain a free fishing and hunting license. The amendment also changes the title and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
