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allocations of \$1,259,701 and \$1,822,137 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the federal share of the increase in the reimbursement rates.

This bill requires a review of rates of reimbursement for consumer-directed personal care attendant services every 2 years 6 beginning January 1, 2002. When the commissioner determines that an increase in one or more of the reimbursement rates is 8 necessary after the review, the commissioner shall adopt routine technical rules to accomplish the increase. Conducting the 10 review and the rulemaking process can be absorbed by the Services utilizing existing budgeted 12 Department of Human If it is determined that an increase in the resources. reimbursement rates is needed, future additional General Fund 14 appropriations and Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will be 16 needed. These amounts can not be determined at this time.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment removes a redundant budgeting provision of the bill. It also increases the total amount personal care attendants working under the 3 consumer-directed programs receive for night work by \$5 per night. This is a decrease from the rate proposed in the bill. The amendment also adds appropriation and allocation sections and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
