2 **Sec. 1. Establishment of commission. Resolved:** That the
Governor shall establish a commission composed of 7 members to
4 recommend to the Governor candidate designs for the Maine state
quarter to be submitted to the United States Mint pursuant to the
6 United States Mint 50 State Quarters Program, referred to in this
resolve as the "program." The commission shall establish
8 guidelines and procedures to disseminate to the public
information concerning the program including the United States
10 Secretary of the Treasury's design criteria and to solicit
candidate designs from the public. The commission shall review
12 the candidate designs submitted by the public and shall recommend
candidate designs to the Governor to assist the Governor in
14 choosing candidate designs to submit to the United States Mint.

This resolve directs the Governor to establish a commission
20 composed of 7 members to recommend to the Governor candidate
designs for the Maine state quarter that the Governor must submit
22 to the United States Mint pursuant to the United States Mint 50
State Quarters Program. The commission shall establish
24 guidelines and procedures to disseminate to the public
information concerning the program including the United States
26 Secretary of the Treasury's design criteria for the Maine state
quarter and to solicit candidate designs from the public. The
28 commission shall review the design candidates and make
recommendations to the Governor to assist the Governor in
30 choosing candidate designs for the Maine State Quarter to submit
to the United States Mint.
