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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 451, L.D. 1326, Bill, "An
Act to Clarify the Authority of the Maine Milk Commission"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 9 in the 7th and
8th lines (page 1, lines 32 and 33 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "milk is subject to pooling requirements under federal
or state law" and inserting in its place the following: 'dealer
is subject to federal milk pricing regulation in addition to
state milk pricing regulation'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment further clarifies that dealers must pay
producers the minimum producer prices established by the Maine
Milk Commission for milk sold in Maine.
