26	or state law" and inserting in its place the following: 'dealer is subject to federal milk pricing regulation in addition to
28	state milk pricing regulation'
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32	SUMMARY
34	This amendment further clarifies that dealers must pay producers the minimum producer prices established by the Maine Milk Commission for milk sold in Maine.
