SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 457, L.D. 1332, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Hunting Animals in Enclosed Areas"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the next to the last line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "License" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in section 1346, license'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§1332.~~" in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "License" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in section 1346, license'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1342.~~" in subsection 3 in the 5th line (page 4, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "All" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in section 1346, all'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1342.~~" in subsection 4 in the next to the last line (page 4, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Transport" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in section 1346, transport'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 by inserting at the end the following:

**'§1346. License fees deposited in General Fund**

4 Notwithstanding section 1331, subsection 2, section 1332 and  
6 section 1342, subsections 3 and 4, the first \$1,120 collected  
8 each year under those sections for license fees for deer farms  
10 and commercial large game shooting areas and transport tag fees  
12 must be deposited in the General Fund.'

20 **FISCAL NOTE**

22 This amendment requires that the first \$1,120 of revenue  
24 collected each year in license fees for deer farms and commercial  
26 large game shooting areas and transport tag fees must be  
28 deposited in the General Fund, eliminating the loss of General  
30 Fund revenue that would have occurred starting in fiscal year  
32 2000-01.

20 **SUMMARY**

22 This amendment requires the first \$1,120 collected each year  
24 in license fees and transport tag fees to be deposited in the  
26 General Fund.
