2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12709, sub-§10**, as amended by PL 1989, c.  
443, §45, is further amended to read:

6 **10. Intercampus cooperation and coordination.** To promote  
8 cooperation among the technical colleges and prepare plans for  
approval by the board of trustees with respect to the  
10 coordination of programs, activities and personnel, including the  
establishment of a uniform system to facilitate the transfer of  
12 credits for equivalent courses between the various colleges of  
the system;

18 This bill adds to the powers and duties of the President of  
the Maine Technical College System in promoting intercampus  
20 cooperation and coordination the establishment of a uniform  
system to facilitate credit transfers between colleges within the  
system.
