- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6421, sub-§5-A, as amended by PL 1995, c. 568, §1, is further amended to read:
- 5-A. Student license eligibility. A student license may only be issued to a person who, at the time of application, is a full-time student not more than 22 years of age. For the purposes of this subsection, "full-time student" means "student" as defined in Title 39-A, section 102, subsection 8, paragraph C. To be eligible for a student license, the full-time student must pass a basic examination given by the department.
