Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §3-A is enacted to read:
§3-A. Waiver of rules
1. Waiver. If a waiver of department rules is requested by a local school administrative unit, the procedures for approval of the waiver must provide the following:
A. Public inspection and participation;
B. Written application for the waiver:
C. Notice to the bargaining agent or agents representing school employees of the waiver request;
D. A right of the bargaining agent to inspect the
application and documentation, state its views and present relevant evidence for consideration; and
E. Written notice to the bargaining agent of the decision
on the application and the reason for the decision.
SUMMARY
This bill establishes a process for the approval of any waiver of rules administered by the Department of Education.
