HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 951, L.D. 1349, Bill, "An Act to Protect Citizens from the Detrimental Effects of Tobacco"

Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1541, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. Immediate family. "Immediate family" means a person's offspring 18 years of age or older, parents or spouse.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 by inserting at the end the following: '"Restaurant" does not include an establishment that is wholly owned and wholly operated by a person and that person's immediate family.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts from the places where smoking is prohibited those restaurants that are owned and operated exclusively by a family.
