HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 951, L.D. 1349, Bill, "An Act to Protect Citizens from the Detrimental Effects of Tobacco"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 19 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: "Restaurant" includes a Class A restaurant and a Class A restaurant/lounge as defined in Title 28-A, section 2.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that the bill prohibits smoking in Class A restaurants and further prohibits smoking in Class A restaurant/lounges, which are establishments that serve full-course meals, but that stop serving full-course meals after 9 p.m. or that maintain a space separate from the restaurant in which liquor is sold at tables, booths or counters.
