24	FISCAL NOTE

28	This amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of the original bill. That fiscal note is included below for informational purposes.
30	This bill may both increase and decrease the number of civil
32	violations filed in the court system. The net effect on the Judicial Department's workload and administrative costs will be
34	minimal. The net effect on the collection of fines will also be insignificant.
36	
38	The Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to enforce these changes to the laws governing smoking in restaurants. These costs can be
40	absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.
