28	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.
30	Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 21 and inserting in its place the following:

34	'21. Removal of beaver dams. Removal of a beaver dam as authorized by a game warden, as long as:
36	A. Efforts are made to minimize erosion of soil and fill material from disturbed areas into a protected natural
38	resource;
40	B. Efforts are made to minimize alteration of undisturbed
42	portions of a wetland or water body; and
44	C. Wheeled or tracked equipment is operated in the water only for the purpose of crossing a water body to facilitate
	removal of the beaver dam. Where practicable, wheeled or
46	<u>tracked equipment may cross a water body only on a rock,</u> gravel or ledge bottom.

50	This exemption includes the draining of a freshwater wetland resulting from removal of a beaver dam. It does not include removal of a beaver house.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 958, L.D. 1356 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

to

12 Exempting the removal of beaver dams from certain permitting requirements will result in insignificant reductions of dedicated 14 revenue to the Department of Environmental Protection from permit fees.' 16

SUMMARY

20 This amendment removes the section from the bill that gives a game warden authority to approve the removal of a beaver dam, 22 because game wardens already have that authority. The amendment also clarifies that a person who removes a beaver dam as 24 authorized by a game warden is exempt from the requirement to get a permit under the natural resources protection laws only if the 26 removal meets certain standards.

The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
