22	Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph H in subparagraph (4) by striking out all of divisions (a) and (b) (page 1, lines
24	37 to 45 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
26	' <u>(a) The percentage of antlerless deer permits</u> issued to nonresident and alien hunters may not
28	exceed the average percentage of applicants for antlerless deer permits over the previous 3 years
30	who were nonresidents or aliens; and
32	(b) No more than 15% of the antlerless deer permits issued in any one district or in any one
34	<u>zone may be issued to nonresident and alien</u> hunters.'
36	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

40	Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 4 by striking out all of lines 1 to 10 (page 2, lines 40 to 49 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

44	'4. Hunting permits. The commissioner may establish the number of wild turkey permits for each wild turkey hunting zone and may issue those permits annually. No-more-than-10%-of-the

6 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2000.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 12 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 14

SUMMARY

18 This amendment limits the percentage of antlerless deer permits and wild turkey permits that may be issued to nonresident 20 and alien hunters to the average percentage of applicants for those permits over the previous 3 years who were nonresidents or 22 aliens. The amendment also limits the number of antlerless deer permits that may be issued to nonresident and alien hunters to 24 not more than 15% of the antlerless deer permits issued in any district or zone and limits the number of wild turkey permits 26 that may be issued to nonresident and alien hunters to not more than 15% of all wild turkey permits issued statewide.
