48	This amendment increases the revenue loss by further expanding the sales tax exemption. As amended, this bill will

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 976, L.D. 1374

1999-00 and \$13,156 in fiscal year 2000-01. The reduction of
these tax collections will decrease the amounts transferred to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing in
those years by \$443 and \$671, respectively. The resulting net reductions of General Fund revenue will be \$8,234 in fiscal year
1999-00 and \$12,485 in fiscal year 2000-01.

SUMMARY

This amendment reallocates the sales tax exemption granted to child abuse and neglect councils by the bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," to the section of law that currently provides an exemption to community action agencies. This amendment also adds a sales tax exemption for child advocacy organizations.
