

Sec. 1. Standards for heat in buildings. Resolved: That the
2 Department of Labor shall establish standards by rule that
require employers to maintain heat in buildings that are occupied
4 by employees. In developing these standards, the department may
incorporate into the standards the occupational guidelines of the
6 department's Work Place Health Division that apply to employees
of State Government. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are
8 routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes,
Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.
