38	This amendment removes from the original bill a requirement
	that a municipality notify the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries

	firearm discharge ordinance. It retains a requirement that
42	within 30 days of its enactment or amendment a municipality send
4.4	to the commissioner a copy of the new or amended firearm
44	discharge ordinance and any maps showing the areas affected by the new or amended ordinance. The requirement applies to an

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ordinance enacted or amended after January 1, 2000.
