## An Act Providing a Tax Credit for Private School Tuition.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5219-Q is enacted to read:
4	§5219-Q. Credit for private school tuition
6	A taxpayer is allowed a credit against the tax imposed by
8	this Part for tuition paid to a private elementary or secondary school in this State for 50% of the cost of providing education
10	for a dependent of the taxpayer. The credit may not exceed 50% of the statewide average tuition allowable under Title 20-A,
12	chapter 219 for tuition at a public school at the dependent's grade level. The credit may not reduce the tax to less than zero.

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill provides an income tax credit equal to 50% of the cost of private elementary and secondary tuition. The credit may
20	not exceed 50% of the statewide allowable tuition for a public school.

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
