This bill may increase the number of civil violations filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

This amendment requires an employer who keeps records in a form other than paper to have available the equipment necessary to review and copy personnel files. It also allows the Department of Labor, as well as an employee or former employee, to bring an action for equitable relief for violations of the law. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
