COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "//" to H.P. 988, L.D. 1386

2 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 4 **'FISCAL NOTE** 6 8 The Department of Public Safety will incur some minor additional costs to prepare and present a proposal to develop and implement a police cadet program. These costs can be absorbed 10 within the department's existing budgeted resources. 12 The Department of Public Safety will require additional 14 General Fund appropriations to implement and fund a police cadet program once the proposal is submitted and reviewed by the 16 Legislature. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. 18 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, The the Department of Conservation, the Department of Marine Resources and the University of Maine System will incur some minor 20 additional costs to assist the Department of Public Safety in the 22 plans to develop a police cadet program. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.' 24 26 **SUMMARY** 28 The amendment replaces the title and the resolve. The amendment expands the scope of planning and potential 30 implementation for the police cadet program to include the entire Department of Public Safety; other state law enforcement 32 agencies, including the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Department 34 of Conservation; municipal law enforcement agencies; and county law enforcement agencies. The amendment also directs the law enforcement agencies to work with the University of Maine at 36

Augusta and directs the Department of Public Safety to coordinate 38 reporting to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
