Reference to the Committee on Criminal Justice suggested and ordered printed.

Presented by Representative TUTTLE of Sanford.

Sec. 1. Police cadet program. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police shall develop and implement a police cadet program for youth who have graduated from high school or have a high school equivalency diploma. The bureau may use existing police cadet programs in this State and in other states as models; and be it further

Sec. 2. Proposal and report. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police shall present a proposal to implement and fund a police cadet program to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice by December 15, 1999.
