SUMMARY

14 This bill requires the Department of Education and State Board of Education to establish a grant-making process for school achievement grants. The department and state board will establish criteria for the awarding of these grants to school 18 administrative units. The bill appropriates \$3,000,000 over the biennium for school achievement grants and provides that these 20 funds are nonlapsing.
