Hunting or Fishing License for \$10.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§6**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 419,
§3, is further amended to read:

6 **6. Armed Forces domiciled in Maine.** A combination fishing
and hunting license must be issued upon payment of \$15 for 1993
8 and \$20 for 1994 and every year thereafter, plus the issuing fee,
to a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active
10 duty who is permanently stationed outside of the State, and to
that person's spouse and children, if that person can show proof
12 that that person's home of record, as recorded in his that
person's service records, is Maine. A hunting license or fishing
14 license must be issued upon payment of \$10, plus the issuing fee,
to a person who qualifies for a combination hunting and fishing
16 license under this subsection. That person must be issued all
other licenses or permits at resident fees. The license is valid
18 during the year of issue.

20 **SUMMARY**

22 This bill allows military personnel domiciled in Maine to
24 obtain either a hunting or a fishing license for \$10.
