28	engage in the licensed activities under subsection 2. A person issued a student license may not submerge at any one
30	time more than 150 lobster traps in the coastal waters of the State. <u>A person may not assist a student license holder</u>
32	in the licensed activities unless that person holds a Class I, Class II, Class III or senior lobster and crab fishing
34	license,'
36	Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph G and inserting in its place the following:

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 2 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 4 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 6 summary the following: 8 **'FISCAL NOTE** 10 1999-00 2000-01 12 **REVENUES** 14 \$5,900 \$5,900 General Fund 16 Authorizing a senior lobster and crab fishing license will 18 increase annual General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Marine Resources by \$5,900 beginning in fiscal year 1999-00.' 20 22 SUMMARY 24 This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources, specifies that a person 26 issued a senior lobster and crab fishing license may fish for, take, possess, ship, transport and sell lobsters and crabs only 28 while assisting that person's child or grandchild who is the holder of a student license. A senior lobster and crab fishing 30 license does not authorize the holder to tend traps other than those submerged by the holder of a student license. The amendment 32 also specifies that only the holder of a Class I, Class II, Class III or senior lobster and crab fishing license may assist a 34 student license holder. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
