2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §1209, sub-§2, ¶¶H and I,** as enacted by PL  
1983, c. 581, §§10 and 59, are amended to read:

6 H. Review the progress and accomplishments of juvenile  
justice and delinquency projects funded under the state  
8 plan; and

10 I. Regularly seek comments and opinions from juveniles  
currently under the jurisdiction of the juvenile justice  
12 system; and

14 **Sec. 2. 34-A MRSA §1209, sub-§2, ¶J** is enacted to read:

16 J. Provide a fund for after-school care by setting aside  
18 10% of funds appropriated to the group in a quality child  
care business fund.

24 This bill requires the Juvenile Justice Advisory Group to  
26 set aside 10% of funds for quality child and after-school care
