Further amend the amendment in section 7 in the last line 8 (page 3, line 34 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "services" the following: '. If the commission requires a 10 limited extension of time to complete its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 14 and inserting in its place the following:

16 'Sec. 8. Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members of the commission are entitled to receive the legislative per diem 18 and reimbursement of necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission; and be it further

Sec. 9. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 22 this resolve.

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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 486, L.D. 1446

2 As amended, this resolve includes an additional General Fund appropriation of \$1,760 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the 4 Legislature for the per diem and expenses of legislative members of the Business Advisory Commission on Quality Child Care 6 Financing and to print the required report.

8 The additional costs associated with providing drafting assistance can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is 10 granted and the commission requires drafting assistance during 12 the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff 14 services.

16 Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read 18 consecutively.

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SUMMARY

This amendment specifies the appointment of the chairs of 24 the Business Advisory Commission on Quality Child Care Financing and the compensation of Legislative commission members and limits 26 the study to one year and 3 meetings.
