	<u>§997-B. Agricultural Products Utilization Commission</u>

20	The Agricultural Products Utilization Commission, as established in Title 5, section 12004-I, subsection 6-F, referred
28	to in this section as the "commission," shall advise the members
30	of the authority on the adoption, amendment or repeal of rules,
50	policies or administrative procedures for carrying out section
32	997-A. In addition, the commission shall advise the members of
	the authority on environmental impact considerations, including
34	the impact that agriculturally derived fuels may have on ground
	water.

	1. Membership. The commission consists of 11 members.
38	Five members must be appointed by the Governor for terms of 2
	years each, arranged so that 2 terms expire in odd-numbered years
40	and 3 terms expire in even-numbered years; 3 of these must be
	actively engaged in farming in this State and 2 members appointed
42	by the Governor must be actively engaged in business in this
A A	State. The Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources
44	shall appoint one member for a term of 2 years, which expires in
16	odd-numbered years. The member appointed by the Commissioner of

expires in even numbered years. Commission members may be
 reappointed to the commission. Terms of members run from the first day of July. The Director of Economic and Community
 Development, the President of the University of Maine, the Commissioner of Environmental Protection and the Commissioner of
 Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, or their designees, are members of the commission. The commission shall elect one of its members as chair.

10 2. Commission meetings; staff. The commission shall meet as necessary and shall report annually to the joint standing 12 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters and the joint standing committee of the 14 Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, food and rural resources matters on the commission's activities and deposits and 16 expenditures from the Agriculturally Derived Fuel Fund. The authority shall provide staff and support services to the 18 commission.'

20 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
22

#### **'FISCAL NOTE**

26 This bill establishes the Agriculturally Derived Fuel Fund to be administered by the Finance Authority of Maine. General 28 Fund appropriations or funding from other sources will be required to capitalize the fund.

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The Finance Authority of Maine will incur additional costs 32 for the per diem and expenses of members of the Agricultural Products Utilization Commission and to provide staff and support 34 services to the commission. These costs can be absorbed by the authority utilizing existing budgeted resources. 36

The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, the 38 Department of Economic and Community Development, the Department of Environmental Protection and the University of Maine System 40 will incur some minor additional costs to participate as members of the commission. These costs can be absorbed within the 42 respective agencies' existing budgeted resources.'
