	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 16 MDSA 8614 cmb 82 and supply her DI 1070 and 400
4	Sec. 1. 16 MRSA §614, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 433, §2, is amended to read:
б	2. Exception to this limitation. Nothing in this section
8	shallpreclude <u>precludes</u> dissemination of intelligence and investigative information to another criminal justice agency <u>or</u> to the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Child and Family
10	Services for use in the investigation of suspected abuse or neglect. Intelligence and investigative information may also be
12	disseminated to an accused person or his <u>that person's</u> attorney, if authorized by:
14	A. The District Attorney for the district in which that
16	accused person is to be tried;
18	B. A rule or ruling of a court of this State or of the United States; or

24	SUMMARY
26	This bill permits the release of reports or records that contain intelligence and investigative information and that are
28	prepared by, prepared at the direction of or kept in the custody of certain state agencies, including law enforcement agencies, to
30	the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Child and Family Services for use in the investigation of suspected abuse or
32	neglect.
