## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1205, sub-§2, ¶¶J and K, as enacted by PL 4 1989, c. 488, are amended to read: 6 The retail licensee must notify the Bureau of Liquor J. Enforcement of the date and time scheduled for an on-premise 8 taste testing; and 10 К. The retail licensee must purchase all wine served at a taste testing from a wholesale licenseer; and 12 Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1205, sub-§2, ¶L is enacted to read: 14 L. The retail licensee must designate an employee 16 responsible for activities of all persons conducting taste testing on the licensee's premises. That responsible employee must be present for the entire period of taste 18 testing on the retail licensee's premises. The retail 20 licensee is responsible for any violations of this section by any person conducting the taste testing. 22 **SUMMARY** 24 26 This bill requires that any retail liquor licensee engaged in taste testing of wine designate an employee who is responsible 28 for the activities of all persons conducting and is present for the duration of the taste testing.
